

ORDINANCE NO. 27-55

By Mr. Seayre

To fix the compensation of laborers and employes, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That subject to the limitations prescribed by the Charter, the Superintendents of the Divisions of Streets, Parks, Water and Building shall have the right to employ such laborers or employes as may from time to time be necessary in the conduct of the affairs of their respective departments.

Section 2. Common or unskilled laborers so employed shall be classified in the following classes, to-wit: a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, p, q, r, s, t, u, v, w, x, y and z, and they shall be paid the following compensation, to-wit:

Class (a)	laborers shall receive \$1.00 per hour
Class (b)	laborers shall receive \$1.05 per hour
Class (c)	laborers shall receive \$1.10 per hour
Class (d)	laborers shall receive \$1.15 per hour
Class (e)	laborers shall receive \$1.20 per hour
Class (f)	laborers shall receive \$1.25 per hour
Class (g)	laborers shall receive \$1.30 per hour
Class (h)	laborers shall receive \$1.35 per hour
Class (i)	laborers shall receive \$1.40 per hour
Class (j)	laborers shall receive \$1.45 per hour
Class (k)	laborers shall receive \$1.50 per hour
Class (l)	laborers shall receive \$1.55 per hour
Class (m)	laborers shall receive \$1.60 per hour
Class (n)	laborers shall receive \$1.65 per hour
Class (o)	laborers shall receive \$1.70 per hour
Class (p)	laborers shall receive \$1.75 per hour
Class (q)	laborers shall receive \$1.80 per hour
Class (r)	laborers shall receive \$1.85 per hour
Class (s)	laborers shall receive \$1.90 per hour
Class (t)	laborers shall receive \$1.95 per hour
Class (u)	laborers shall receive \$2.00 per hour
Class (v)	laborers shall receive \$2.05 per hour
Class (w)	laborers shall receive \$2.10 per hour
Class (x)	laborers shall receive \$2.20 per hour
Class (y)	laborers shall receive \$2.30 per hour
Class (z)	laborers shall receive \$2.40 per hour

Section 3. Employees whose services are but casual shall be classified in the following classes, to-wit: a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j, l, m, n, o, p, q, and r, and they shall be paid the following compensation, to-wit:

Class (a)	employees shall receive \$1.70 per hour
Class (b)	employees shall receive \$1.80 per hour
Class (c)	employees shall receive \$1.90 per hour
Class (d)	employees shall receive \$2.00 per hour
Class (e)	employees shall receive \$2.10 per hour
Class (f)	employees shall receive \$2.20 per hour
Class (g)	employees shall receive \$2.30 per hour
Class (h)	employees shall receive \$2.40 per hour
Class (i)	employees shall receive \$2.50 per hour
Class (j)	employees shall receive \$2.60 per hour
Class (k)	employees shall receive \$2.70 per hour
Class (l)	employees shall receive \$2.80 per hour
Class (m)	employees shall receive \$2.90 per hour
Class (n)	employees shall receive \$3.00 per hour
Class (o)	employees shall receive \$3.25 per hour
Class (p)	employees shall receive \$3.50 per hour
Class (q)	employees shall receive \$3.75 per hour
Class (r)	employees shall receive \$4.00 per hour

Section 4. Truck and driver so employed shall be classified as a, b, c, d, and e. Class (a) shall receive a maximum of \$2.25 per hour; Class (b) shall receive a maximum of \$2.75 per hour; Class (c) shall receive a maximum of \$3.25 per hour; Class (d) shall receive a maximum of \$3.75 per hour; Class (e) shall receive a maximum of \$5.00 per hour.

Section 5. All bills for labor shall be approved by the Mayor and shall be paid from the appropriation for the Department in which said services shall have been rendered.

Section 6. Ordinance No. 17-48, passed August 3, 1948, is hereby repealed.

Section 7. This Ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into immediate force and effect.
