

ORDINANCE NO. 28-55

By Mr. Hunt

Providing for modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after January 1, 1956, and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows per month, payable semi-monthly:

- (a) Chief of Police \$405.00
- (b) Police Sergeants \$362.00
- (c) Patrolmen - First 6 Months \$315.00  
Second 6 Months \$320.00  
Second Year \$330.00  
Third Year and Thereafter \$345.00
- (d) Equipment Maintenance Mechanic \$420.00
- (e) Custodian of Jeffrey Property \$311.00
- (f) Secretary to Mayor and Auditor \$290.00  
(Payable \$270.00 out of General Fund and \$20.00 out of Water Works Fund)
- (g) Superintendent of Streets \$550.00
- (h) Assistant Superintendent of Streets \$360.00  
(Payable \$325.00 out of Service Fund and \$35.00 out of Water Works Fund)
- (i) Superintendent of Water \$380.00
- (j) Custodian of Municipal Building \$300.00  
(Said monthly salary shall be payable \$225.00 out of the General Fund and \$75.00 out of the Water Works Fund)
- (k) Director of Recreation - June, July, August \$412.00
- (l) Director of Recreation (Other 9 months of year \$206.00)
- (m) Secretary of the Board (Part Time) \$90.00

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary in the daily operations of the various departments of the City government for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city and shall be in full force and effect from and after the 1st day of January, 1956.
