

RESOLUTION NO. 1 -56

By Mr. Wardell's

Appointing a board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expenses of improving Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to the east corporation line.

Whereas, it has been determined by council to assess the whole cost, less 2 percent thereof and the cost of intersections, of the improvement of Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to the east corporation line in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, that William Graessle, James Dixey and Carl Johnson, three disinterested freeholders of said City be and they are hereby appointed to a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in Ordinance No. 10-55 to improve said street, passed May 24, 1955, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council the estimated assessment.
