ORDINANCE NO. V-56

By: Mr. (3),

To authorize the Mayor to enter into a cooperative contract with the City of Columbus. Ohio, providing for the improvement of Gould Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue and the distribution of the cost thereof.

Whereas, a petition has been filed with this council praying for the improvement of Gould Read from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue, and

Whereas, the corporation line of the City of Bexley and the City of Columbus is in the center line of Gould Road between the points named, and

Whereas, the City of Columbus has indicated its desire to participate in such improvement and to this end has caused the preparation of the necessary plans, specifications and estimates of costs therefor, and

Whereas, an emergency exists in that it is necessary to provide for a cooperative agreement by and between the two cities in order that the improvement may be completed at the earliest possible time thereby preserving the public health, peace and safety; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Bexley, Ohio, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a cooperative agreement with the City of Columbus, Ohio, covering the improvement of Gould Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue under the supervision of the chief engineer of the City of Columbus in accordance with the plans marked 1657, drawer D, the specifications and the estimates of costs as apportioned between the two cities for said improvement, all of which are on file in the office of the director of public service of Columbus, copies of which are on file in the office of the Mayor and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That said agreement shall provide for the apportionment of the cost of said improvement, the manner of accumulating funds necessary to pay the cost thereof in the treas ry of the City of Columbus and the final distribution between said two cities of the cost therefor.

Section 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
