

ORDINANCE NO. 5-56

To establish rules and regulations with regard to conversion of property by a bailee.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person, with intent to defraud, shall sell, secrete, destroy, convert to his own use, or otherwise dispose of chattels, goods, merchandise, or personal property, the possession of which has been given to him in trust, pledge, bailment, or on deposit, or under an agreement to purchase it on installment payments or otherwise, and no person so holding such property, shall with intent to defraud, remove it beyond the county wherein it was stipulated such property should be kept.

Section 2. Whoever violates Section 1 of the foregoing ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.
