

RESOLUTION NO. 5-56

Declaring the intention of Council to proceed with the construction of a sewage disposal plant for the City of Bexley.

Whereas, the City of Bexley has no contract for the transportation, disposal and treatment of the sewage of its residents, and

Whereas, the contract it formerly had with the City of Columbus has expired and we have been unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract with the City of Columbus, and

Whereas, for the proper protection of the health and safety of our residents it has become necessary for the City of Bexley to construct its own sewage treatment and disposal plant, and

Whereas, the values of property located in the City of Bexley, will be adversely protected if adequate sewage disposal and treatment is not available at a reasonable and fair rate, and

Whereas, studies have been made by our engineers and preliminary recommendation made by them and it appears obvious that it will be necessary to install a trunk sewer along the east bank of Alum Creek between Main Street and Livingston Avenue, and

Whereas, such studies have advised us that the logical and best location for such a plant is on the east bank of Alum Creek south of Astor Avenue, and

Whereas, the City of Columbus is endeavoring to appropriate a right-of-way which is absolutely necessary for the completion of our plans and such location is not necessary to the City of Columbus because of possible alternate routes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF Ohio:

Section 1. That it is the intention of this council to proceed as rapidly as possible with the construction of a sewage disposal and treatment plant and the trunk sewers and lines and connecting sewers and lines in connection therewith.

Section 2. That the engineers are hereby directed and instructed to establish a definite location of all rights-of-way in connection therewith.

Section 3. That the engineers are hereby directed and instructed to bring in their recommendation for the location of the disposal plant, the size of the plot of ground necessary for the same and the type of construction of the same.

Section 4. That the City Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and to have executed such easements as may be necessary to follow the line determined by the engineers, width of the same to be determined by the engineers.

Section 5. That it is the intention of this council to appropriate such land and easements as cannot be acquired by negotiation.

Section 6. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and

approval by the Mayor.
