

ORDINANCE NO. 7-56

To establish rules and regulations for the prohibition against abuse of or abetting delinquency of child.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That no person shall abuse a child or aid, abet, induce, cause, encourage, or contribute to the dependency, neglect, or delinquency of a child or a ward of the juvenile court, or act in a way tending to cause delinquency in such child. No person shall aid, abet, induce, cause, or encourage a child or a ward of the court, committed to the custody of any person, department, public or private institution, to leave the custody of such person, department, public or private institution, without legal consent. Each day of such contribution to such dependency, neglect, or delinquency is a separate offense.

Section 2. That whoever violates Section 1 of the foregoing ordinance shall be fined not more than \$50.00.
