

ORDINANCE NO. 17-56

To amend Section 62 of Ordinance 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a Traffic Code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That paragraph (f) of Section 62, Stop Intersections, of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (f) All streets intersecting Cassingham Road, from the north line of Livingston Avenue to the north corporation line, except where Cassingham Road intersects through highways, Columbus Street, Allegheny Avenue and Delmar Drive.

Section 2. That existing paragraph (f) of Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because of the urgent necessity for the proper control of traffic in the vicinity of Cassingham School and for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
