

ORDINANCE NO. 13-56

To increase the limits of petit larceny violations and to repeal the former ordinance No. 42-48.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Whoever steals anything of the value of less than \$60.00 shall be deemed guilty of petit larceny, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00, together with costs of prosecution.

Section 2. Existing ordinance No. 42-48 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
