

ORDINANCE NO. 19-56

Providing for the purchase of a used packer type refuse body of approximately the same size and operation of the present Garwood bodies we now have in use, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one used packer type refuse body, for use in the collection of garbage & refuse, said body type to be fully enclosed and designed to obtain the utmost in the way of sanitary conditions and construction, the same to be fully equipped for use according to specifications, as the Mayor may deem proper and best.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. Such advertisement shall provide that bids will be received for such used body. The sum of \$3400.00 is hereby appropriated from the Service Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that additional trucks for collection of garbage and refuse are immediately necessary, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon the passage thereof.
