

ORDINANCE NO. 70-56

Providing for the purchase of a trailer mounted brush clipper, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one trailer mounted brush clipper, to have at least four 12 inch blades, to be operated by a gasoline engine of ample size to operate clipper unit without undue strain, all to be mounted on an all steel, welded construction rubber tired trailer, all to be equipped with all necessary tools and equipment to make a complete self-contained unit.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$3200.00 is hereby appropriated from the Service Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the City has been notified to discontinue the burning of brush, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
