

ORDINANCE NO. 21-56

Providing for the reduction of the assessment for lights against Sally B. Gertner, Lot No. 119, Ardmore Addition, because of inequality.

Whereas, three of the lots on the corner of Ardmore and Powell were assessed for lights in Ordinance No. 15-52 on a side lot basis but Lot No. 119 on the southwest corner was assessed on a front footage basis; and

Whereas, it is the desire of this Council to correct this inequality.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment passed in Ordinance No. 15-52 against Lot No. 119, Ardmore Addition, now owned by Sally B. Gertner, be reduced in the amount of \$100.00.

Section 2. That a copy of this ordinance be mailed to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, so that he can make such a reduction in said assessment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
