

ORDINANCE NO. 23-56

To authorize and direct the Mayor and Auditor to pay for the sewer replacement in the alley west of Kenwick, out of the Sewer Fund in place of the General Fund as originally authorized, said sewer replacement having been made jointly with the City of Columbus by authority of Ordinance No. 18-54 and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, at the time of the passage of Ordinance No. 18-54 the City of Bexley had no Sewer Fund and for that reason our share of the cost was appropriated from the General Fund; and

Whereas, the work is now completed and we have been billed for our share by the City of Columbus; and

Whereas, the City of Bexley now has a Sewer Fund;

Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$9,674.10 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund for the purpose of paying our share of the sewer repair authorized by Ordinance No. 18-54.

Section 2. That the appropriation of \$7,200.00 from the General Fund for the same purpose, as authorized by Ordinance No. 18-54, is hereby cancelled and repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in that the sewer has been repaired in accordance with our agreement and the money herein appropriated is now due the City of Columbus, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
