

ORDINANCE NO. 25-56

To levy special assessments for the removal of dead and diseased trees where the work was not done by the owner after being ordered by the City and it was necessary for the City to do the work and assess the owner.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of cutting the dead and diseased trees on the properties and owners hereinafter listed, amounting in the aggregate to \$ 798.20, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed upon the lots and lands upon which the dead and diseased trees were removed.

the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the clerk of this council, and which assessments are for the actual cost of removing said dead and diseased trees from said land and lots and are not in excess of special benefits to said property and are not in excess of any statutory limitation.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within three days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in two annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the Auditor of said City. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said three days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the county auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
