

ORDINANCE NO. 26-56

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to the east corporation line of this City by grading and paving the roadway with concrete base, with asphaltic concrete wearing course, constructing concrete curbs and gutters and sidewalks and doing such other things as were necessary to complete said improvement, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the City of Bexley share of the cost and expense of improving Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to the east corporation line of this city by grading, draining and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement upon a Portland cement concrete foundation with combined curbs and gutters, constructing sidewalks and doing such other things as were necessary to complete said improvement amounting in the aggregate to \$57,800.35, as reported to this council on June 26, 1956, by the board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, to-wit: all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the northerly side of Livingston Avenue from College Avenue to the east corporation line of this City, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the clerk of this council and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits and are not in excess of any statutory limitation.

Section 2. The total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the treasurer of said city. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said assessments will not be on the tax duplicate for the year 1956 unless this ordinance is effective immediately, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
