

ORDINANCE NO. 28-56

To transfer money from the Sewer Fund to the General Fund as herein specified, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,225.75 paid The Jennings-Lawrence Company for survey and information as to the cost, location and other data on a sewage disposal plant for the City of Bexley which sum was paid out of the General Fund, be paid out of the Sewer Fund by transferring said amount from the Sewer Fund to the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in that said money is needed in the General Fund.
