

ORDINANCE NO. 32-56

Establishing a schedule of fees to be charged for the issuing of permits and licenses by the several governmental departments.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following schedule of fees is hereby adopted for the issuing of licenses or permits by the several governmental departments of the City, and the fee or fees herein provided shall be charged by the issuing authority or authorities for the following licenses and permits hereafter issued, to-wit:

(A) Building Permits:

1. Single, double or duplex houses shall be charged a minimum fee of \$20.00 plus \$1.00 per thousand cubic feet over 20,000 cubic feet.
2. Apartment buildings shall be charged a minimum fee of \$10.00 per living unit, and where the building is occupied by business offices in addition to living quarters, the business portion shall be at the rate of \$1.00 per hundred square feet of floor space or portion thereof, with a minimum fee of \$10.00 for such business or office portion.
3. Commercial buildings or other buildings not mentioned above shall pay a minimum fee of \$20.00 plus \$1.00 per hundred square feet, or fraction thereof, of all floor space, including cellar and basement, over 2000 square feet.
4. For alterations and additions the fee shall be \$2.50 for first \$500.00 or portion thereof, plus \$2.50 for second \$500.00 or portion thereof, plus \$2.50 for each additional \$1,000.00 or portion thereof, based on valuation.
5. For garages, carports and auxiliary buildings used in connection with house or apartment unit, the fee shall be \$4.00 for single garage or carport, plus \$1.00 for each additional unit.

(B) Plumbing Permits:

1. There shall be a fee of \$3.00 for first fixture or opening plus \$.75 for each additional opening or fixture, and permits for alterations or repairs to any sanitary plumbing system shall be computed at the same rate.
2. The above fees for plumbing shall be doubled if any plumbing work has been commenced before an application for a permit for such work has been filed with the building inspector. Such double fees shall not apply to an emergency or urgently necessary work, if a permit for such work is obtained as provided.

(C) The following fees shall apply for licenses and other permits:

1. Master Plumber's License - \$10.00 for each calendar year;
2. Journeyman " " \$1.00 " " " " ;
3. Electrician's " " \$5.00 " " " " ;
4. Sewer Tapper's " " \$5.00 " " " " ;
5. Driveway permit, each \$2.00;

6. Sidewalk permit, each \$2.00;
7. Heating and air-conditioning permit, each \$5.00;
8. Sewer permit, each \$5.00.

Section 2. That the fees shown in the foregoing schedule shall be in lieu of the fees heretofore fixed by any ordinance or ordinances for the issuing of such respective licenses or permits.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the 1st day of January 1957.
