

ORDINANCE NO 35-56

Providing for the modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after Jan 1st, 1956, and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows per month, payable semi-monthly:

- (a) Chief of Police \$ 480 -
- (b) Police Sergeants \$ 387 -
- (c) Patrolmen - First 6 Months \$ 340 -
Second 6 Months \$ 345 -
Second Year \$ 355 -
Third Year and Thereafter \$ 370 -

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
