

ORDINANCE NO. 4-57

To amend Section 67 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Paragraph 7 of Section 67 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

7. Pleasant Ridge, from Main Street to the first alley south of Main Street, east side thereof, provided, however, that such parking shall not exceed thirty minutes;

Section 2. That existing Paragraph 7 of Section 67 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that it is necessary to immediately restrict said parking in order to provide for persons purchasing automobile licenses, and said amended ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
