

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -57

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Gould Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue by grading and paving the roadway with concrete base, with asphaltic concrete wearing course, constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks and doing such other things as were necessary to complete said improvement.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the City of Bexley's share of the cost and expense of improving Gould Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue by grading, draining and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement with Portland Cement concrete foundation with combined curbs and gutters, constructing sidewalks and doing such other things as were necessary to complete said improvement amounting in the aggregate to \$27,910.40, as reported to this council on February 26, 1957, by the board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed and that it be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, to-wit: all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the westerly side of Gould Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the clerk of this council and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits, and are not in excess of the special benefits to said property and are not in excess of any statutory limitation.

Section 2. The total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the treasurer of said city. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
