

ORDINANCE NO. 10-57

To authorize the Mayor, who is also the Director of Public Service, to enter into a contract with the City of Columbus for the discharge of sewage, industrial wastes, water or other liquid wastes from the City of Bexley, into, and the transportation, pumping and treatment of the same, by, the Sewerage System and the Sewage Treatment Works of the City of Columbus.

Whereas, an emergency exists in that it is necessary to enter into this agreement at once because none now exists and it is necessary to have a contract at the earliest possible time thereby preserving the public health, peace and safety; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor, who is also the Director of Public Service, on behalf of the City of Bexley, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the City of Columbus, Ohio, to provide for the discharge of sewage, industrial wastes, water or other liquid wastes from the City of Bexley, Ohio, into, and the transportation, pumping and treatment of the same, by, the Sewerage System and the Sewage Treatment Works of the City of Columbus, Ohio, which said agreement has been drafted and prepared by both the City of Bexley and the City of Columbus, Ohio, and is now in a form satisfactory to the City Attorney of Columbus, Ohio, and the City Solicitor of Bexley, Ohio, and a copy of which said agreement is on file in the office of the Mayor of the City of Bexley, and the execution of which agreement was authorized by the Council of the City of Columbus on April 22, 1957.

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
