

ORDINANCE NO. 6 -58

By Mr. Bell

To prohibit disturbances of the peace.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person shall after a request to desist, make, continue or cause to be made by the use of any horn, bell, radio, loud speaker, or by the operation of any instrument or device, any unreasonably loud, disturbing, and unnecessary noise or noises of such a character, intensity and duration as to disturb the peace and quiet of the community or to be detrimental to the life and health of any individual, and no person shall willfully conduct himself or herself in a noisy, boisterous or other disorderly manner by either words or acts which disturb the good order and quiet of the community.

Section 2. Whoever violates this section shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) and not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
