

ORDINANCE NO. 8-58

To levy special assessments for the repair of sidewalks.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of repairing the sidewalks amounting in the aggregate to \$201.30, as reported to this council by the Mayor, notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are now on file in the office of the clerk of this council, and are not in excess of the special benefits to said property, and are not in excess of any statutory limitation.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot shall be payable in cash within thirty (30) days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in one annual installment without interest. All cash payments to be made to the treasurer of said city. All assessments remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty (30) days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the county auditor, as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
