ORDINANCE NO. 15-58

To designate non-parking areas on Mound Street and College Avenue,  
and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following areas shall be designated non-parking  
areas and no person shall stand, or park a vehicle therein, unless in compliance  
with the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device;

Mound Street, the south side thereof, from the west  
curb line of College Avenue to a point 75 feet west  
thereof;

Mound Street, the south side thereof, from the east  
curb line of Sheridan Avenue to a point 75 feet east  
thereof;

Mound Street, the north side thereof, from the east  
curb line of Sheridan Avenue to the west curb line of  
College Avenue;

College Avenue, west side thereof, from the south  
curb line of Mound Street to a point 75 feet south  
thereof.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance  
shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by  
a fine of not more than \$50.00, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure, because of the urgent necessity for the proper control of traffic, and for  
the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and shall take effect  
and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
