

ORDINANCE NO. 2-60

Providing for the purchase of two trucks for municipal purposes and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one truck chassis within the 2 ton class, to have enclosed cab and accessories and to exchange thereon one 1947 Chevrolet dump truck, Serial No. 9QWK 4289, Motor No. EEA 557330 and for the purchase of one 3/4 ton pick-up truck to have enclosed cab and accessories and to exchange thereon one 1929 Chevrolet 1 1/2 ton truck, Serial No. 91Q7971, Motor No. 613356.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. Such advertisement shall provide that bids will be received for said trucks separately. The sum of \$5800.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said trucks are necessary for the daily operations of the city's governmental functions and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
