

RESOLUTION No. 3 60

Declaring it necessary to hold a public hearing to consider the proposed amendment to Ordinance No. 456 and also referring the same to the Planning Commission.

Whereas, an ordinance has been prepared and submitted to Council, which ordinance consists of an amendment to our present zoning ordinance; and

Whereas, under the Ohio law it is necessary to hold a public hearing and give thirty days notice of the time and place of said hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in this city; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a public hearing be held on July 12, 1960 at 7:00 P. M. in the City Municipal Building to discuss and consider the proposed ordinance to amend Article II Section 2 d of Ordinance No. 456 as provided in said ordinance.

Section 2. That the clerk give at least thirty days notice of the time and place of said meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in this city.

Section 3. That, from the date of the notice until the date of the hearing, a copy of the proposed ordinance shall be on file, for public examination, in the office of the Mayor.

Section 4. That a copy of said ordinance be furnished the Planning Commission with the request that they approve or disapprove the same before said public hearing.
