Section 2. That the public hearing be held on the 245 day of Novely, 1960, at 7:00 P. M., in the Bexley Municipal Building to discuss and consider the proposed ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 456.

Section 3. That the Clerk give at least thirty (30) days notice of the time and place of said meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in this city and written notice, by first-class mail, at least twenty (20) days before the hearing, to the owners of property within and contiguous to and directly across the street from the parcels intended to be rezoned, to the addresses of such owners appearing on the county auditor's current tax list or the treasurer's mailing list.

Section 4. That, from the date of the notice until the date of the hearing, a copy of the proposed ordinance be kept on file for public examination in the office of the Mayor.
