

ORDINANCE NO. 6-60

Providing for the purchase of two automobiles for use of the Department of Public Safety and general municipal purposes, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized, to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new two-door sedan, with standard equipment, two windshield wipers, heavy duty generator adaptable to police cruiser work; heavy duty battery to operate radio and other equipment (bidder shall specify if 6 or 12 volt battery, also quote on both types if practical); spare wheel; heater; two arm rests; rear compartment or trunk space to accommodate Red Cross Equipment, the same not to exceed \$3,000.00 in cost, and to exchange thereon one (1) 1958 Chevrolet 2-door sedan, Serial No. D58N-149845, from which the present owner will remove the spot light, the siren and radio for installation in the automobile to be purchased and for the purchase of one two door coupe, the same not to exceed \$3,000.00 and to exchange thereon one (1) 1952 Chevrolet Business Coupe, Motor No. KAA 201107, Serial No. 9KJC 2993.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Safety Fund and \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Departments are in need of said automobiles and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
