

ORDINANCE No. 11 - 60

To amend Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That paragraph (f) of Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

(f) All streets intersecting Cassingham Road, from the north line of Livingston Avenue to the north corporation line, except where Cassingham Road intersects through highways and Delmar Drive;

SECTION 2. That Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be, and the same is, hereby amended by the addition of a stop intersection as follows:

(gg) Cassingham Road shall stop for Columbus Avenue.

SECTION 3. That existing paragraph (f) of Section 62 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic situation requires immediate action to improve it and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
