

RESOLUTION NO. 1 - 61

Declaring it necessary to hold a public hearing to consider the proposed amendments to Ordinance No. 456.

WHEREAS, four ordinances have been prepared and submitted to this Council, each of which contains an amendment or amendments to our present zoning ordinance; and

WHEREAS, under the Ohio law it is necessary to hold a public hearing and give thirty days notice of the time and place of said hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in this city; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That a public hearing be held on February 14, 1961, at 7:00 P. M. in the city Municipal Building to discuss and consider the four proposed ordinances to amend Ordinance No. 456.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk give at least thirty (30) days notice of the time and place of said meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in this city.

SECTION 3. That from the date of the notice until the date of the hearing, copies of each proposed ordinance shall be on file, for public examination, in the office of the Mayor.

SECTION 4. That a copy of each ordinance be immediately submitted to the Planning Commission for approval, disapproval or suggestions and that they be given thirty (30) days for their consideration and report.
