

ORDINANCE NO. 5 -61

To amend Section 71 of Ordinance No. 30-51 being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, ~~and to declare an emergency.~~

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 71 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 71. Night Parking

(a) No vehicle shall be parked or left standing on any street or alley in the City of Bexley between the hours of 2:00 A. M. and 6:00 A. M., unless a special parking permit has been issued therefor.

(b) Such special parking permits may be issued by the police department, under the supervision of the Safety Director, where reasonable accommodations are not available, and the application for such permits shall contain such information as may be deemed necessary by the Safety Director.

(c) A new permit shall be required for each calendar month, the cost of the same shall be four dollars (\$4.00) per month, and such permit shall be placed in the lower left hand corner of the windshield or in such other conspicuous place as the police department may designate.

(d) Physicians and surgeons in emergency situations are exempted from the terms of this section.

Section 2. That existing Section 71 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance ~~is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect~~ shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
