

RESOLUTION NO. 6 -61

WHEREAS, this Council considers it advisable and helpful to the voters of this City that a copy of Ordinance No. 14-61 be mailed to such voters together with a statement outlining the reasons for the passage of the ordinance, so that such voters will have time to study it before election day; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to have printed and to mail to all persons having water taps a copy of Ordinance No. 14-61, together with a statement outlining the reasons for its passage.

SECTION 2. That the cost of such printing and mailing is hereby appropriated from the General Fund.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is an emergency measure, necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, because of the proximity of the election, and said resolution shall go into immediate force and effect.
