

ORDINANCE NO. 7 -61

Due to conditions and ordinances in effect in the Greater Columbus Area and whereas it is deemed advisable to make the following changes as it applies to holidays, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. To provide for the payment of six (6) termed legal holidays for all hourly paid City employees as follows: New Year's Day, Decoration Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day, provided herewith that hourly employees shall be paid at the regular single time basis for the above mentioned days, provided, however, that it will be required that the employee be working on the nearest working day before and after such holiday is celebrated, otherwise he shall not be paid for the holiday in question unless he be sick and unable to work and shall be required to furnish statement from a Doctor if requested by any of his superiors or otherwise excused for a bonafide reason.

Section 2. The above conditions apply only to steady employees and to those who have been steadily employed for a period of one year.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
