

ORDINANCE NO. 10 -61

To repeal Ordinance No. 5 -61 and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, this council is of the opinion that parking in residential areas in this City needs to be restricted because of its interference with the flow of traffic; and

WHEREAS, this council is of the opinion that the gradually increasing number of cars tends to increase this interference; and

WHEREAS, this council realizes that in some sections of the City it may be necessary to weigh various factors before adopting a permanent plan; and

WHEREAS, no overall survey has been made by a competent traffic engineer for some years; and

WHEREAS, this council is willing to delay the enactment of a permanent ordinance until a further study can be made, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 5 - 61 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and said Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
