

ORDINANCE NO. 22-61

Providing for the appointment of two additional patrolmen in the Division of Police, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the positions of two additional patrolmen are hereby created in the Division of Police, and such patrolmen may be appointed by the Mayor from lists submitted by the Civil Service Commission, at the salary heretofore provided by Ordinance 17-61.

One to be appointed effective as soon as certified by the Civil Service Commission and the other to be appointed effective January 1, 1962.

Section 2. This Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, as provided by law.
