

ORDINANCE NO. 6 - 62

To amend the definition of Emergency Vehicle in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 31-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the paragraph defining an EMERGENCY VEHICLE in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 31-51 be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

EMERGENCY VEHICLE. Fire department, police and state highway patrol vehicles, vehicles of salvage corporations, organized under Sections 9873-9879, both inclusive, of the General Code, and emergency vehicles of municipal departments or public utility corporations or any vehicle authorized by the Safety Director, when identified as such as required by law, the director, or local authorities, and motor vehicles when commandeered by a police officer, ambulances and motor vehicles when used by volunteer firemen responding to emergency calls in the fire department service when identified as shall be required by the director.

Section 2. That the existing paragraph defining an EMERGENCY VEHICLE in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 31-51 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, said emergency being the necessity to designate a vehicle as an emergency vehicle, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
