

ORDINANCE NO. 7 -62

To determine to proceed with the improvement of the west half of Gould Road from Broad Street to Main Street by paving the roadway, constructing sidewalks, and doing other work incidental thereto, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That it is the intention of this council to proceed with the improvement of the west half of Gould Road from Broad Street to Main Street by paving the roadway, constructing sidewalks and doing other work incidental thereto in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 1-62.

Section 2. That this council hereby adopts the estimated assessments prepared and filed in accordance with Resolution No. 1-62.

Section 3. Since no claims are on file, it is unnecessary to state whether or not they shall be judicially inquired into before commencing or after completing the improvement.

Section 4. That the sum of \$85,755.25 is hereby appropriated from the general fund to cover the estimated cost of said improvements, and the Auditor is authorized and directed to deposit the same with the Treasury of the City of Columbus to be placed to the credit of the "Gould Road, Broad Street to Main Street Improvement Fund", and shall be used for no other purpose.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the public health, welfare and safety for the reason that construction must proceed without delay, and it shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
