ORDINANCE NO. 9 -62

To amend Section 43 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 43 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 43. RIGHT OF WAY AT THROUGH HIGHWAY; STOP SIGNS; TRAFFIC SIGNALS

- (a) The operator of a vehicle, intending to enter a through highway, shall yield the right of way to all other vehicles or trackless trolleys on said through highway.
- (b) The operator of a vehicle or trackless trolley shall stop in obedience to a stop sign at an intersection where a stop sign is erected and shall yield the right of way to all other vehicles or trackless trolleys not so obligated to stop.
- (c) At College Avenue and Parkview Avenue, where these streets dead end at Main Street, no operator of a motor vehicle will be permitted to come out of a private drive and proceed across Main Street but must follow the directional green arrows either to the right or to the left.
- (d) The operator of a vehicle eastbound on Main Street in the curb lane will be permitted to make a continuous right turn into College Avenue, with caution, on the green arrow, but shall yield the right of way to pedestrians lawfully within a crosswalk.
- Section 2. That existing Section 43 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic problems connected with the above amendment are in need of immediate solution and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
