

ORDINANCE NO. 19-62

To modify Section 65 of Ordinance No. 30-51 being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 65, paragraph 6 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is modified to read as follows:

(6) Within 20 ft. of a crosswalk at an intersection except the ~~(6) 60 ft. end of the crosswalk instead of 20 ft. on the south side of Mound Street at the southeast corner of College and Mound only~~ southeast corner of Mound and College which shall be 60 ft.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Fifty Dollars and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic problems connected with the continuous right turn south on College and then making a left turn east on Mound Street in connection with the above modification are in need of immediate solution and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
