

RESOLUTION 2-63

A resolution declaring the necessity of constructing certain sidewalks in the City of Bexley requiring that abutting property owners construct same and declaring an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct sidewalks in the City of Bexley in accordance with specification as designated in Ordinance 11-48 and estimate of cost prepared by the Street Commissioner and now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council and in the following location;

EAST BROAD STREET

Edward S. Merkle - c/o Mark Merkle - 132 South Chesterfield Road
(Reserve A - Bexley East Sub Division Ext.)

Section 2. That the owners of all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed sidewalks shall construct in accordance with plans and specification as set forth in Ordinance No. 11-48. The portion of such sidewalks abutting on their respective properties within a period of forty-five (45) days after service of notice of this resolution; and, if such construction shall not be completed within such period of forty-five (45) days, then this Council shall have the same done and the entire cost thereof shall be assessed upon the property of defaulting owner and made a lien thereon, to be collected in the manner provided by law with penalty and interest as provided by law.

Section 3. That the Clerk of this Council is directed to cause a written notice of passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.


Section 4. The plans specifications and estimate of cost of said construction as heretofore filed are hereby approved.

Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that the immediate construction of such sidewalks is urgently required to permit safe passage and to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrians; Wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and effect in and immediately after passage.


