

RESOLUTION NO. 4-63

Declaring it necessary to hold a public hearing to consider the rezoning of Reserve "A" of Bexley East Subdivision Extension, same being located on the south side of East Broad Street, from Merkle Road to Gould Road.

WHEREAS, an ordinance has been prepared and submitted to this Council which provides for rezoning the above property to permit the erection of multiple dwellings; and

WHEREAS, under the Ohio law it is necessary to hold a public hearing and give thirty (30) days notice of the time and place of said hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That a public hearing be held on Tuesday, July 23, 1963, at 7:00 P. M. in the Bexley Municipal Building to discuss and consider the ordinance to permit the erection of multiple dwellings in Reserve "A" of Bexley East Subdivision Extension located on the south side of East Broad Street between Merkle Road and Gould Road.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk give at least thirty (30) days' notice of the time and place of said meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in this corporation and give at least twenty (20) days' notice of the time and place of said meeting by first class mail to the owners of property within and contiguous to and directly across the street from the above property, to the addresses of such owners appearing on the county auditor's current tax list or the treasurer's mailing list.

SECTION 3. That from the date of the notice until the date of the hearing, copies of the proposed ordinance shall be on file, for public examination, in the office of the Mayor.

SECTION 4. That a copy of the ordinance be immediately submitted to the Planning Commission for approval, disapproval or suggestions and that they be given thirty (30) days for their consideration and report.
