

RESOLUTION NO. 5-63

Declaring it necessary to hold a public hearing to consider the rezoning of both sides of Delmar Drive from the first alley east of Cassady Road to Stanwood Road.

WHEREAS, an ordinance has been prepared and submitted to this Council which provides for rezoning the above property to permit limited commercial use as may be permitted by Council; and

WHEREAS, under the Ohio law it is necessary to hold a public hearing and give thirty (30) days notice of the time and place of said hearing;  
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a public hearing be held on Tuesday, July 23, 1963, at 8:00 P. M. in the Bexley Municipal Building to discuss and consider the ordinance to rezone both sides of Delmar Drive between the first alley east of Cassady Road and Stanwood Road to permit limited commercial use as restricted and provided in said ordinance.

Section 2. That the Clerk give at least thirty (30) days' notice of the time and place of said meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in this corporation.

Section 3. That from the date of the notice until the date of the hearing, copies of the proposed ordinance shall be on file, for public examination, in the office of the Mayor.

Section 4. That a copy of the ordinance be immediately submitted to the Planning Commission for approval, disapproval or suggestions and that they be given thirty (30) days for their consideration and report.
