

ORDINANCE NO. 18-63

To amend Section 71 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 71 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 71. TRUCKS, BUSES, BOATS, TRAILERS,
NIGHT PARKING

No motor truck, bus, boat, ^{HOUSE TRAILER} or trailer shall be parked or left standing on any street or alley in the City of Bexley, longer than six hours, between the hours of ten o'clock P. M., and six o'clock A. M., of the following day.

Section 2. That existing Section 71 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic problems connected with the above amendment are in need of immediate solution and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
