

ORDINANCE NO. 23-63

To reappropriate moneys from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the various appropriations within said Fund for the current operations of the several governmental departments, as herein specified, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the appropriations within said fund hereinafter set forth, for the current operation of the various departments herein shown, to-wit:

- (a) \$100.00 from 1C3 to 1C4 in the Mayor's fund.
- (b) \$ 50.00 from 1C5 to 1C4 in the Mayor's fund.
- (c) \$500.00 from 4L9 to 4L1 in Street Repair fund.
- (d) \$500.00 from 15B2 to 15B3 in Parks fund.

Section 2. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Sewer fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Sewer fund for the current operation of the sewer department.

- (a) \$1,700.00 from 4T9 to 4T7 within Sewer fund.
- (b) \$1,900.00 from 4T8 to 4T7 within Sewer fund.
- (c) \$ 400.00 from 4T6 to 4T7 within Sewer fund.
- (d) \$ 100.00 from 4T5 to 4T7 within Sewer fund.
- (e) \$ 400.00 from 4T3 to 4T7 within Sewer fund.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the daily operation of various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and adoption upon the approval thereof.
