ORDINANCE NO. 3-64

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE CITY OF BEXLEY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, IN THE MATTER OF THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IMPROVEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Director of Highways, under authority of Section 5501.11 of the Revised Code of Ohio, and in cooperation with the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio and the City of Columbus is considering improving a portion of Livingston Avenue, inclusive of the bridge over Alum Creek, in connection with the construction of the East Freeway (Interstate Route No. 70) in the City of Columbus, and

WHEREAS, a portion of said bridge and the east approach thereto will encroach on territory within the corporate limits of the City of Bexley, and

WHEREAS, Section 5521.01 of the Revised Code of Ohio requires that the Director of Highways shall first obtain the consent of the legislative authority of any such municipal corporation in which work is to be performed by said Director.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1.

That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said City be and such consent is hereby given to the Director of Highways to construct the above described improvement, in accordance with plans, and specifications as prepared by said Director, all without cost to the City of Bexley.

Section 2.

That the Director of Public Safety and Service of said City, is hereby authorized to enter into such agreements as may be necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this ordinance.

Section 3.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure by reason of the need for expediting construction of said improvement to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
