

ORDINANCE NO. 4 -64

Authorizing the purchase of three (3) trucks for municipal purposes and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) 3/4 ton truck chassis and cab, to have standard equipment, including heater, defroster and directional lights and to exchange thereon a 1949 Chevrolet 6 cylinder 3/4 ton chassis and cab. Motor No. AGCA44600, Serial No. 9 GRA 1368.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) three ton truck chassis, cab and dump body, to have standard equipment, including heater, defroster and directional lights and to exchange thereon a 1954 Chevrolet 6 cylinder three ton chassis, cab and dump body, Motor No. 0186449F54P, Serial No. W54N 008287.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) three ton truck chassis and cab, to have standard equipment including heater, defroster and directional lights and to exchange thereon a 1949 Ford 6 cylinder three ton chassis and cab, Motor No. 97 HT 168 796, Serial No. 9H8T.

Section 4. That said contracts shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder or bidders after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public, peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said trucks are necessary for the daily operation of the city's governmental functions and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
