To declare the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the City of Bexley and that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of such limitation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the tenmill limitation for the benefit of the City of Bexley for the purpose of current expenses of said city at a rate not exceeding three (3) mills for each one dollar of valuation, the same being a renewal of an existing levy, which amounts to No dollars and thirty cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years.

Section 2. That said levy be placed upon the tax list for the current year, if fifty per centum of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. That the Clerk of this Council be, and he hereby is, directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections, Franklin County, Ohio, prior to the 15th day of September, 1964 and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
