

ORDINANCE NO. 6-64

By Crawley

Providing for modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after 15<sup>th</sup> Day April, 1964 and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows per month, payable semi-monthly:
