

ORDINANCE NO. 17 -64

To appropriate money to pay for the city's share of the cost of improving Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue west a distance of approximately 225 feet, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$824.00 is hereby appropriated from the water fund for the purpose of paying the cost of the water line work incidental to the improvement of Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue west a distance of approximately 225 feet.

Section 2. That the sum of \$3,458.50 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the purpose of paying the balance of the cost of the improvement of Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue west a distance of approximately 225 feet, over and above the amount of \$8,350.00, which is to be assessed against the abutting property owners.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in that until the money is available, the contract cannot be signed and the work commenced, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
