

ORDINANCE NO. 20-64

Providing for the purchase of a Tractor-Loader Backhoe for use of the Water-Sewer and Street Departments, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized, to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new Tractor-Loader Backhoe complete with standard equipment, the same not to exceed \$7,000.00 in cost, and to exchange thereon one (1) 1948 International High Lift, Serial No. 1BKM K 8714.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund, \$1,000.00 from the Water Fund and \$1,000.00 from the Sewer Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said departments are in immediate need of said Tractor-Loader and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
